### As linguists, we will:

learn to talk about school life in French.

### As geographers, we will

We will be observing plants closely in their habitats and working scientifically by recording and classifying.

read texts related to Olympic sports and Olympic athletes like 'The Boy who biked around the world' and 'Proudest Blue' by fencer, Ibtihaj Muhammad. We will write explanation texts about our favourite Olympic sports.

### In PSHE, we will:

strive to aim high! Setting goals and celebrating achievements, think about what our futures could look like. Perhaps we have some future Olympians in our midst.

### As food technicians, we will:

Design, make and evaluate recipes for different athletes depending on the skills they need for their sport.

### As athletes, we will:

learn how to play tennis and practise a range of athletics events including running, jumping and throwing. All in preparation for Sports Day.

### As IT specialists, we will:

learn how to present information about ourselves using Microsoft PowerPoint.

### As musicians, we will:

listen to and learn songs from the Disco genre about peace, unity and togetherness.
