Additionally, we ask that children in Class 1 are picked up at the door of the classroom by their parent, so that staff are able to hand the children directly over. We have to keep all the other children safe as they wait.

All of them have worked together to create a fantastic design, which they presented to the PTA in order to secure some funding! The PTA also discussed many other ongoing ventures.
