Wow, what a busy week we have had! There has been a real buzz in the air as the children have launched into their new topics. We hope you have had a chance to look at the topic webs sent out last week and they are available to view on the website if you would like to see how the topics progress.

Class 1 are busy learning about themselves in their topic 'All About Me' whilst also exploring their new outdoor area. A huge thank you to Jo Pearson for coordinating it throughout the summer holidays. Class 2 are learning about Healthy Me and Healthy Planet. I have seen some excellent writing based on The Storm Whale. The children will be able to tell you the story having learnt it in class using the storytelling approach. Class 3 are learning about Fun Fit, particularly investigating how our bodies work through a science focus. I have personally really enjoyed teaching in Class 3 this week whilst exploring their English text The Jungle Book. This book has been used to inspire some really excellent pieces of descriptive writing full of suspense.
