### Hello from Landulph Little Owls

After a month of operation, our new after-school club has finally been named – since we are the opposite to the breakfast early birds, we are now Landulph Little Owls (with credit to Miss Colebrook-Clarke!). As an 'incomer' to Landulph this term I was struck by the good-humoured and vibrant atmosphere of the school, and LLO has become a happy extension to the school day with children from all classes enjoying the club.

Myself and Mrs Thomas offer two sessions: from 3:15p.m to 4:15p.m, and then until pick-up time at 5:30p.m, with a healthy snack break halfway through, when we welcome children from the other after-school clubs to join us. We offer activities including painting, colouring, lego, a playdough table, a reading corner and use of laptops for cbeebies games, with a different craft activity every day like junk modelling, papermache or puppet-making. We have outside play every day when we explore the field or use multi-skills games in the playground, and the first session on Friday is a homework club. In the next week we are making a scarecrow for the Harvest Festival – so any spare newspapers to stuff him would be welcome!
