

## Sport Premium Statement

The Government has given primary school extra funding to help promote PE and health. At Landulph School, we make sure PE and the promotion of a healthy lifestyle has a very high profile. Improving and maximising our provision in PE is one of our School Improvement priorities this year. The extra money we have received this year has enabled us to provide the following:

- Access to all opportunities in attending local, county and inter county-wide competitions via our School Sport Partnership, where we have, for many years, excelled in competitive team sports.
- Quality PE sessions provided on a weekly basis by PE experts from Saltash.net.
- An improved programme of staff CPD working alongside PE experts and specialists and learning from them.
- Sport Premium funding has enabled our PE co-ordinator and members of our school council to choose and purchase a number of new pieces of equipment to further enhance our PE provision.
- We have used Sport Premium funding to buy into the 'Arena Sports' package which entitles us to 6 sessions on Forest Schools (4 sessions) for each class within the school.
- Special whole school theme days including 'Tri-Golf'.
- We have used Sport Premium money to pay for the 'Bikeability' programme for our Year 6 pupils, encouraging them to stay safe on the local roads.
- An excellent provision of after-school sports clubs, featuring; netball, football, tag rugby and cross country. These clubs are free for pupils to attend.
- Sport Premium money has been used to purchase a new scheme of work for PE, in line with the new primary curriculum for Key Stage 1 and 2.
- We are holding our own sports day this year and will, once again, take part in the 'area sports' events.
- We have recently linked with another school for an outdoor education project - where we will be developing outdoor learning for all our pupils.
