A message from Mrs Ball

As I'm writing this newsletter to you, we have not yet had a confirmed case of Covid 19. As I'm sure you have heard in the local news, a number of primary schools in Cornwall and Plymouth have been less fortunate. If a case was to be confirmed at Landulph I would like to share our procedures with you in case you have any questions you would like to ask or would like some reassurance.

What would we do if a member of staff tested positive?

Like all of us, our staff are following government guidelines and so if they showed any symptoms they would stay home or be sent home immediately and self-isolate until they were tested. If they have Covid-19 then they will continue to self-isolate together with their whole household for 14 days. We would also, of course, contact Public Health and Test and Trace to keep them informed.

We ask Teachers and TAs which children and adults they have been in close contact with in the 48 hours before their symptoms emerged and we send these children and adults home. We are aware that it may be that all of the class have been in close contact with the teacher and so it may be necessary to send the whole class home.

What would we do if a child tested positive?

If the child shows any Covid-19 symptoms then their whole household must follow government guidance and immediately self-isolate until tested. If any member of your household has Covid-19 then your whole household will self-isolate for 14 days.

The school will send home all children and adults who have been in close contact with the child in the 48 hours before their symptoms emerged. There are two groups which the school decides to send home.

1. The bubbles that the child was in during the 48 hours before their symptoms are sent home. These include the bus they are on and the class they are in.
2. Teachers are asked if they have been in close contact

There are a number of reasons why the school may decide to send fewer children home. Such decisions will always seek the support of Public Health. Some of these reasons are listed below.

1. If the child was at home for the 48 hours before symptoms, such as after a weekend.
2. If a child is normally in a bubble such as a bus but were not in that bubble in the 48 hours prior to their symptoms emerging.

I would like to reassure you that we will continue to do all that we can do to minimise the risks and take a precautionary approach whenever possible. Should a bubble be sent home then we will ensure that the curriculum will continue providing home learning as we did during lockdown last term (see further information below).

Thank you for your continued support through these difficult times and we are incredibly grateful for all that you are doing to help us keep our community safe.

Home Learning

In the event of us having to close a 'class bubble' because of a positive COVID result, we will be using Microsoft Teams as a platform to deliver home learning. It can be accessed on any device that has an internet browser. There is also an app available for Apple and Android devices.

Further details will be sent out over the next few weeks, but in the first instance – if your child does not have access to a device that is able to run Microsoft Teams then please email secretary@landulph.cornwall.sch.uk. We need you to let us know if you have any technical issues that could hinder your ability to support online learning from home.

World Mental Health Day 2020 is the most important one yet. This year has been a tough one for us all. The months of lockdown and loss have had a huge impact on our mental health.


